★ Report from our AOS liaison, Mike Vaupel:

The American Orchid Society Fall Membership Meeting was held on Saturday, October 28. Jay Balchan, President, gave the opening remarks. He stated that AOS currently has approximately 10,000 members worldwide, and 200,000 Facebook views and 25,000 Instagram views.

A new AOS website is coming that will look something like the National Geographic website, and may have the Ghost Orchid in situ on the opening page. He also said that the rare orchid books collection and pictures/paintings have been moved from the AOS library at Fairchild to an "Iron Mountain" storage facility 15 miles away that has a safer environment (better A/C, security, etc.). One hundred boxes of books, paintings and pictures were moved.

The AOS Spring Members Meeting will be held April 5 - 7, 2024 in conjunction with the Apopka International Spring Orchid Festival. Finally, Orchid Wiz will no longer be updated, and Orchid Pro will try to replace it. Artificial Intelligence (AI) could be used in the future to ID plants, but not right now.
