Yolanda Cuesta from Quest Orchids in Miami
will present her "No Frills" Repotting
Demonstration and Workshop at our meeting
on Monday, March 11th. She will also show us
how they prepare an orchid for a show. As a
professional grower, Yolanda has many years
of experience repotting orchids quickly. So
come and see how the pros do this fast and
efficiently.



What you need to bring:

- 1. One healthy Cattleya or Dendrobium to re-pot that is in active growth or not. If it needs repotting this is the time, OR bring a piece of an orchid that needs to be potted in a fast-draining mix.
- 2. The orchid you bring for repotting cannot be larger than 8-inch diameter due to time constraints.
- 3. A clean or new pot for your orchid to accommodate 2 years growth.
- 4. Your own clippers, gloves if you wish and a tool you use to remove your plant. For example, a butter knife.
- 5. The Society is providing the media to re-pot up to 45 orchids Cattleya or Dendrobium.
- 6. If you don't have an orchid to re-pot, come to help others and watch and learn Yolanda's techniques, the secrets of an expert!

Yolanda and Segundo Cuesta opened Quest Orchids 30 years ago.

They specialize in Art Shade Cattleyas which are atypical flower colors, and cloning old standards. They are hybridizers, and grow Vandas and some Dendrobiums species. Quest is one of the premier orchid growers in Florida and has earned many AOS awards for their beautiful well grown orchids. Located in Miami: 12110 SW 43rd St., (305) 219-2883. **questorchids.net**


